President Derek Wing called the November meeting of the McKenzie Fire & Rescue Board of Directors to order at 12:03 p.m. on Monday, November 18th, 2024, at the Leaburg Training Center, 42870 McKenzie Highway, Leaburg, Oregon.

<u>Approval of Board Meeting Minutes</u>: Lee Means moved to accept the minutes, as presented, of the October 21, 2024, Board meeting. George Burnette Dillon seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: A motion to file the treasurer's report for the month of October, subject to audit, was made by Bruce Daniel. Raymond Byrne, Jr. seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Chief's Report: Chief Bucich's written report was included in the Board packet.

Also discussed:

PIER Grant: Lane County will be managing the grant. We are waiting on the next steps.

EWEB Fuels Reduction Grant: We are working on a public announcement and invite to bid. Chief Bucich will be scheduling a public meeting once these things are in place to discuss wildfire safety and fuels reduction.

16-2 Roof Damage: A tree fell across the back of 16-2's roof. A portion of the roof will need to be replaced. Because of the extent of the damage, this will be turned in to the insurance company.

Digital Sign: The award of the 2023 SAFER grant included \$30,000 to be used toward the purchase of a new digital sign in front of 16-3. Recently, the District received \$48,000 in additional grant funds from Special Districts Association of Oregon. Chief Bucich proposed using \$15,000 of the unexpected SDAO funds along with the awarded \$30,000 for the purchase and installation of a new digital sign.

Following discussion, Bruce Daniel moved to spend up to \$15,000 of the SDAO grant award toward the purchase of the new digital sign, along with the \$30,000 from the awarded SAFER grant. George Burnette Dillon seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Solar Panels: Following discussion about proposed solar panels to be installed at 16-3, the Board would like Chief Bucich to continue to obtain quotes for solar panels.

Personnel: Chief Bucich reported that Training Officer Captain David Sherwood gave notice. His last shift was Monday, November 4th. The current plan is to divide David's duties between the current staffing:

Recruit & Retention, Student Program: Carmen Pierce Training Records, Training Calendar: Lane Palahniuk

EMS/Recertification Hours: Lieutenant Clayton Canfield

Lieutenant Jeff Fox has been able to cover shifts in the interim. The open position has been advertised and will close on December 3rd. Interviews will follow.

GMRS Radios: The District remains involved without being involved in the management.
